2. Previous minutes approved. Matters arising - none	
3. Tree planting. All the trees have now been planted. JF thanked RK and SLJ for all their behind the scenes work planning and their help with planting. A total of 86 people were involved with the planting. Only 6 trees are not growing currently. TA will plant an oak tree in memory of his brother (European Turkey Oak). We need to protect the bigger trees ASAP, before the deer find them. It was agreed that a few of the committee would meet on Friday at 6pm to install posts and chicken wire.
